Guess what programming team has come up with this little cracker? AM3, believe it or not! Once they'd finished *Sega Rally* they turned their attention to a manic arcade game called *Baku Baku Animal* on the Sega Titan arcade board. As you know, this board has the same chip-set as the Sega Saturn so a conversion to the console was a simple task.

The basic idea is to match up the animal heads with their food. Monkeys need bananas, pandas chomp on eucalyptus leaves, rabbits on carrots and dogs gnaw bones. If you manage to match them up they scoff any food that is linked together and send more icons falling down on the opposition's side of the screen.

Highly addictive, great to play with friends and a scream

And here it is! Arcade perfect and absolutely mad! It's got all the options you could want including one player challenges against all kinds of weird creatures and a brilliant two-player versus mode with five levels of speed and difficulty.

It's quite simple to match up the odd head and food icon, but the way to win is to set up spectacular chain reactions. If you manage to get two or three in a row you'll hear a cry and your competitor's screen will fill up with odd icons! The end of the game is marked by a giant lion's head that chomps down on the screen!



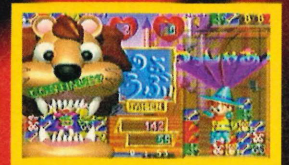
● Arrggh! The lion has chomped down on player-two so it must be game over!

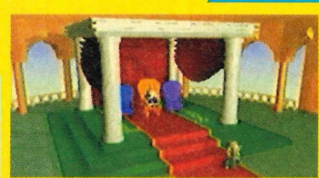
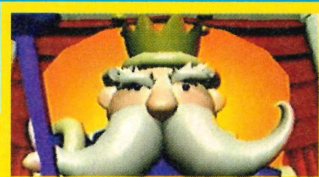
